Other duties, dependent on interests and skills	 Promoting LCC via social media Brining ideas for topics Helping to invite guests from local organizations Helping to cover other LCC sessions if needed and possible

Commitment	2 hours a week plus regular team and support meetings. We would ask for a minimum of 4 months commitment after training has been completed.
